## 1st Thursday

**Pack meetings** are held on the first Thursday of each month from 7-8 pm at the NWUMC Fellowship Hall. The monthly pack meeting brings together boys from every den, their leaders, and their families, to participate in a large-scale event that serves as a showcase for everything the boys have learned and done in their individual den meetings. Meetings include a flag ceremony, scout recognition, songs, skits, learning, prizes and more. Scouts who arrive before 7 pm in full uniform will receive a BONUS raffle ticket. We encourage the whole family to participate in the Pack meeting.

## Last Thursday

**Pack Leadership Committee meetings** are held on the last Thursday of each month from 7:30-9 pm at NWUMC in Room 24. Leaders come together monthly to review and plan the operations of the pack. Parents are welcome to attend to observe or to volunteer in a leadership position.

**Fall Family Campout** is an annual event where scouts and their families enjoy the outdoors together. This overnight event is a great opportunity for parents, siblings, and their scouts to take an exciting adventure into the natural world. Scouts camp with their parent or guardian and generally provide their own tent and bedding. Small fees are associated with this event, which cover park fees, lunch and dinner on Saturday, and breakfast on Sunday. See the Pack website for more details.

**Arlington Parade of Lights** in downtown Arlington is an annual event where scouts participate in the city's parade. This event occurs after dark, so all participants are required to wear lights and/or glow sticks in scout uniforms and can include Christmas accessories.

**Caroling** at the Waterford on Cooper is an annual event where scouts sing Christmas carols and distribute Christmas cards to the residents at a local assisted living and memory care facility. This event is a terrific chance for scouts to participate in a community service project and to spread joy during the holidays.

**Pinewood Derby** is one of the largest Pack events of the year. Scouts, siblings, and even adults build and decorate their own race cars from BSA approved kits. The event is FREE and provides pizza, cookies, and drinks (donations accepted). Extended family and friends will also enjoy watching each car race multiple times across a long track with a digital finish line. Awards are given for several design categories and trophies for speed by den and overall. All participants receive a special pinewood derby patch too. Attend the workshop to utilize tools and receive advice to build your cars with veteran racers. Turn-in cars at the pre-race checkin to be entered into the design judging.

**Scout Sunday** is the day the United Methodist Church designates to celebrate the Scouting Anniversary Day, which is the primary date to recognize the contributions of young people and adults to Scouting. Scouts also receive a specialty patch.

**Blue and Gold Banquet** is the highlight of the year. The purpose of the blue and gold banquet is to celebrate the cub scouts completing their arrow of light rank, thank pack leaders and other adults who have helped the pack, and inspire the leaders, Scouts, and parents. The evening includes dinner and a silent auction for donated desserts. This event is a wonderful chance to include extended family and friends in the celebration.

**Spring Family Campout** is an annual event like the fall family campout (above). See the Pack website for more details.

**Bridging** is an annual event where scouts receive their rank advancement badges and walk across a bridge to earn their new rank's neckerchief.

**Twilight Camp** is a week long day camp in the evenings. It is jam packed with activities and education for scouts. Camp card sales in the spring could even provide enough funds for scouts to attend for free.

**Rain Gutter Regatta** at NWUMC is an annual event where scouts and siblings construct and decorate a catamaran style boat from a Boy Scouts of America (BSA) approved kit to be raced head-to-head. Races are held in pairs of rain gutters filled with water and propelled by the racers blowing into the sail. Everyone races in at least two races with their den and can go on to race against other dens in the finals. Participation ribbons are handed out to all and awards to the top 3 in each den plus top 3 overall. See the Pack website for more details.
